The Municipality of Wawa is seeking interested students for a full time summer position as Recreation Programmer. The Recreation Programmer will assist the recreation coordinators in delivering municipally programmed activities; leading sports, games and creative activities.

The position is cosponsored by the Ministry and the Ministry of Government and Consumer Services. The position is part of the Government of Ontario's Summer Employment Opportunities program known as the 2017 Summer Experience Program. The successful candidate will be expected to start July 3rd and will work no later than August 25th. The candidate will be required to work a minimum of 217.5 hours during that period at a pay rate of \$11.40. The work schedule will include some evening and weekend hours.

- Excellent people skills and a friendly, responsible, service-oriented attitude
- Strong communication and teamwork abilities
