

Inspection of MNRF-Approved Prescribed Burn Plan for White River Forest

The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) invites you to inspect the MNRF-approved prescribed burn plan that will be carried out in the White River Forest (see map).



As part of our ongoing efforts to regenerate and protect Ontario's forests, some recently harvested areas have been selected to be burned under the guidelines of the MNRF's *Prescribed Burn Manual*. The prescribed burn will prepare and enhance the site(s) for subsequent regeneration and growth. **The burn is scheduled for ignition between September 1, 2023 and October 31, 2023**.

The approved prescribed burn plan, including specific locations and maps, is available electronically for public inspection by contacting Nawiinginokiima Forest Management Corporation and on the Natural Resources Information Portal at https://nrip.mnr.gov.on.ca/s/fmp-online from August 1, 2023 until March 31, 2024, when the Annual Work Schedule expires. The burn location is east of Highway 631 near Beaton Lake, roughly halfway between White River and Hornepayne.
