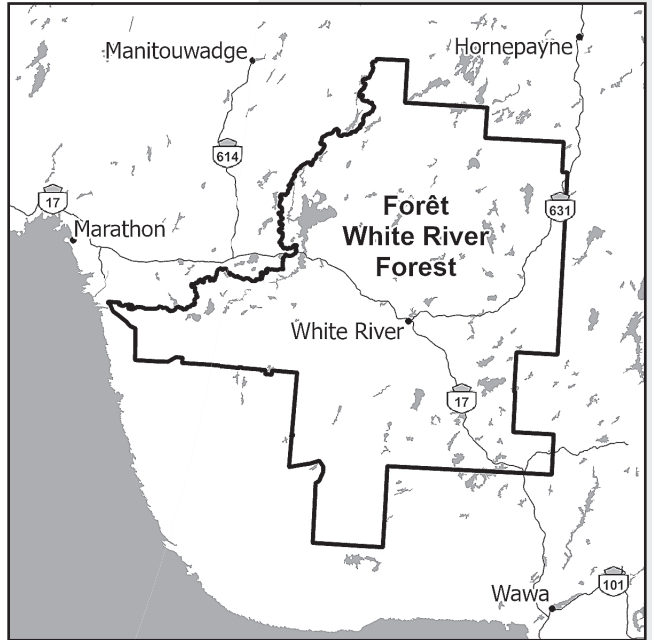
Minor Amendment Review

White River Forest 2018-2028 Forest Management Plan

The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR), Nawiingnokiima Forest Management Corporation (NFMCC) and the White River Forest Local Citizens' Committee (LCC) invite you to review a minor amendment to the 2018-2028 Forest Management Plan (FMP) for the White River Forest and to provide comments.

This amendment provides for:

- Extension of Pokei Lake Road (Primary) Road Corridor
- Addition of McMaster Lake (Branch) Road Corridor
- Addition of Obatanga Creek (Branch) Road Corridor
- Removal of 620 and 620-A (Branch) Road Corridors
- Contingency harvest swap of 584.7 hectares (CP-18-540, CP-18-543, CP-18-552 to regular harvest)



Comments and/or concerns from those affected by the operations with respect to this minor amendment must be received within the 15-day review period and no later than **April 8, 2025** by Brian Harbord of the MNR Chapleau-Wawa office, see contact information below. If no concerns have been raised following the 15-day review period, the minor amendment will be approved. After approval the amendment will remain on the Natural Resources Information Portal for the duration of the FMP at <https://nrip.mnr.gov.on.ca/s/fmp-online>.
