

Request for Proposal

The Ontario **Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR)** invites you to participate in a request for proposal for resource-based tourism development opportunities in the **Chapleau-Wawa District**.



The Opportunity

The Chapleau-Wawa District is currently seeking proposals from qualified individuals and corporations interested in developing and operating new commercial resource-based tourism establishments in the Foleyet area. The ten (10) locations were formerly used as commercial outpost camp operations (fishing, hunting, etc.). The ministry would like to see these lands redeveloped and used for commercial resource-based tourism operations once again to contribute to the local area economy. To support Indigenous economic development, this opportunity includes additional considerations for Indigenous applications. More information can be obtained through the request for proposal.

How to Get Involved

The opportunity at these locations is being done through a competitive submission based on a request for proposal. Proposals must be received by the ministry no later than **October 9, 2026** and will be scored against criteria set by the ministry.

The Ministry of Natural Resources is collecting your personal information under the authority of Section 2, 16, 17, 20, 21 of the *Public Lands Act*. It will be used for the purposes of identification, enforcement and administration of occupational authority or issuance of letters patent.
